Disability Policy

Carnoustie Panmure is committed to ensuring that access to the football club for disabled and less-able supporters and staff is as effective and efficient as we can make it and that they are able to enjoy their time with us at Laing Park.

Carnoustie Panmure will ensure that there is no discrimination between disabled people with differing impairments and will make every effort to comply fully with its legal obligations as set out in the Equalities Act 2010.

The club has carried out a full review of ground access and facilities alongside Angus Access Panel and will review on an annual basis.

The board of the football club are fully aware of their responsibilities in supporting people who need extra assistance. There is always someone available to open the main gate for supporters using wheelchairs or mobility scooters. The main entrance is always attended by a board member with a responsibility for ensuring all patrons enter safely.

Complaints or suggestions for improvement will be discussed and acted upon at a full board meeting.

Any complaint of discrimination by our staff or customers will be fully examined by the board at their first available meeting.

Disabled Parking is available in the Car Park with the spaces close to the pavilion and marked.
